Hiking Gear Rental

Hiking gear rental services(hiking shoes, hiking clothing, etc.) are available for foreign tourists visiting the Seoul Hiking Tourism Center for hiking purposes.



Tourist Information Services

Attractive Seoul hiking tourism information is provided through multilingual (English, Chinese, Japanese) guidance services tailored to foreign tourists. Additionally, Seoul tourism guidebooks, maps, and promotional materials are available.



Lounge and Photo Zone

Three most common Hiking Trails in Bugaksan Mountain



Trail A

Difficulty: Easy | Chunghugwan to Cheongwadae Observatory Course | 2.18km | Duration: 1 hour

This course offers a panoramic view of Seoul's city center from the Cheongwadae Observatory. From here, Cheongwadae, Gyeongbokgung Palace, and Gwanghwamun Gate, all the way to Seoul City Hall, are visible at once.

Trail B

Difficulty: Intermediate | Baegakmaru to Changuimun Gate Course | 3.32km | Duration: 2 hours and 30 minutes

This course allows visitors to enjoy the urban landscape blended with a forest of trees while walking along the Seoul Hanyangdoseong Trail.

Trail C

Difficulty: Advanced | Malbawi to Changuimun Gate Course | 4km | Duration: 3 hours

One of the oldest hiking courses in Mt. Bugaksan, this trail offers a view of the beautiful Samcheong-dong, which is considered one of the most charming areas in Seoul.

Directions to the Center (Mt. Bugaksan)

- 01 From Incheon International Airport**
 - Take airport bus No.6011 from Incheon Airport Terminal 1 (T1) 1st floor or Incheon Airport Terminal 2 (T2) B1 floor bus stop → Get off at Anguk St., Insa-dong bus stop → Walk for approximately 16 minutes
- 02 From Anguk Station**
 - Exit from Exit 1 of Subway Line 3 Anguk St. and go straight (135m) → Make a right turn and continue straight, passing between the Seoul Museum of Craft Art and Yeolrin Songhyeon Green Plaza (430m) → Keep going straight between the entrance of Jeongdok Library and a convenience store (40m) → After turning left at the first alley, continue straight (200m) → Make a right turn at the Samcheong Police Box and continue straight (215m) (Total walking time is approximately 15 minutes)
- 03 From Gwanghwamun Station**
 - Take the bus (No. Jongno 11) at the KT Gwanghwamun Branch bus stop in front of Exit 2 of Gwanghwamun St. on Subway Line 5 → After 3 stops, get off at Samcheong Police Box bus stop → Walk for 2 minutes

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
